PUMKIN PATCH

- 2 families max in pumpkin patch at one time
- Hands must be sanitised prior to entering
- Each family is allowed to pick one free pumpkin to take home with them. Adults must not touch any other pumpkin except the ones they wish to purchase
- Additional pumpkins can be purchased for £3



MARQUEE

- Adults must wear masks when entering marquee there is no exceptions on mask wearing. We will not put our staff in danger if cannot wear mask you will be refused entry into indoor areas unfortunately
- Masks will be available
- Adults must social distance within marquee
- Hot drinks & Doughnuts can be purchased and mask can be taken off in designated area
